Summary:

There were 3sighting reports this month. The coyote gates have been down for most if not all the month. The limited sightings could be due to the breeding/nesting season along with the gates being down.

Date	Time	Location	Description
5/1/2017	11:59 p.m.	Foster Road and Walker Lee	I was taking one of our dogs out to go potty before turning in for the night. She was sniffing down at the curb on Foster Road. I was heading toward the door and turned to call her in when I saw a large German shepherd size coyote sneaking up on our 70 pound Plott Hound. I yelled out at it just as she spotted it. Thankfully it ran off toward Copa De Oro and our dog didn't give chase. She came back inside probably as shook up as I am about witnessing a potential attack on our pet.
5/14/2017	10:50 p.m.	Chaucer Rd./Kempton Dr. - Kempton Park + Channel	Two coyotes were running from Chaucer Rd. to Kempton Park and then to the bordering channel.
5/14/2017	11:30 p.m.	Copa de Oro between Christy and Bellwood	I was out for a late-night run and was headed down Copa de Oro from Foster towards Silver Fox. On the block between Christy and Bellwood, a coyote came running out of the yard upon my approach, and crossed the street and headed up Copa de Oro towards Foster. I watched it warily to make sure it wasn't stalking me, but it seemed to have no interest in me and after I turned onto Silver Fox I didn't see it again.
