August 15 – September 19, 2016 Coyote Reporting Summary

Coyote activity sightings have decreased since the June/July report.

Summary:

11 reports submitted, 7 coyote sightings, 4 remains.

- 5 of the sightings are late night / early morning sightings (bwn 11:00 p.m. & 6:00 am)
- 4 reports of cat remains, two separate incidents

| Date | Time | Location | Description |
|------|----------|---|--|
| 8/10 | 3:00 am | 3200 block Woodstock road | Medium size approx. 30 pounds. Had my Yellow Lab of 70 lbs at 300am. Notice the coyote stalking my lab from the rear however when my dog apparently smelled it and turned around and growled it ran off towards Montecito. Looked to me as if it was in attack mode. |
| 8/14 | 11:30 pm | Martha Ann between Bostonian and Piedmont | The first coyote, small/medium in size ran from the east side of the street to the west side and into the yard of what I believe is 11901 Martha Ann Drive. The second coyote, much larger, was standing on the northeast corner of Piedmont and Martha Ann. It crossed Piedmont and started walking south on Martha Ann toward Bostonian. |
| 8/15 | 11:20 pm | Orangewood & Weatherby | Two adult looking coyotes were walking across Weatherby rd near the riverbed. We have seen them in the same spot three different times within the last two and a half weeks. |
| 8/15 | 11:55 pm | Bradbury & Chaucer | Two coyotes. Took our dog outside to relieve himself. Our dog was agitated and barking at side gate facing Chaucer. I went to look to see two coyotes heading away from our side yard and proceed North on Chaucer. |

I yelled and walked sternly toward coyotes.

| 8/28 | 8:30 pm | Wallingsford and Harrisburg Road | On a walk. Two adults, male and female with 22 month old baby. The coyote ran by within 10 to 15 feet. Coyote was fairly large. Coyote did not return. |
| 9/2 | 8:00 am | Front yard of 2671 Mainway Dr. Rossmoor | My husband found the remains of a cat in our front yard. The tail was in our flower bed and the small amount of remains were in our neighbors yard (one house west). I had heard a cat crying around 8pm the night before. I should have paid closer attention. What really upset me, was at the time that I heard this, my husband was in our backyard, meeting with a group of friends, and both of our dogs were out there. These coyotes are now aggressive and fearless. |
| 9/4 | 3:15 pm | Intersection of Copa de Oro and Silver Fox | Observed a white cat leg (whole lower extremity) laying in the street. Appeared fresh, no bird or insect activity noted. |
| 9/4 | 2:30 pm | Intersection of Copa de Oro and Silver Fox | White hind leg of a cat with bone and muscle exposed. |
| 9/4 | 10:30 am | Copa de Oro and Silver Fox | Found a cat paw laying on the side walk. |
| 9/14 | 7:15 am | He jogged from Old Mill Rd & crossed Bradbury at a driveway leading into the townhouses | He looked like a very thin German Shepherd. I was out for my usual morning run and on my way home (he was less than a block from my house) and he crossed the street in front of me as if he were taking his usual straight path to the townhouses' driveway. By the way, in over a dozen years with morning runs, he was the first coyote I've seen. |
| 9/16 | 12:01 am | On Wallingsford between orangewood and Harrisburg | Two coyotes one larger probably male and one smaller coyote. Both looked starving and were out hunting. Our dog chased them down the street, and we lost track of them. |
