September 19 – October 18, 2016 Coyote Reporting Summary

Coyote activity sightings have decreased since the June/July report.

Summary:

10 reports submitted, 6 coyote sightings, 4 remains.

- 2 of the sightings are late night / early morning sightings (bwn 11:00 p.m. & 6:00 am)

Date	Time	Location	Description
09/19/2016	10:00 pm	Spotted 2 Coyotes at the intersection of Huntley & Wallingford, headed east on Huntley.	They seemed medium sized (not aware of the size ranges) & were headed east on Huntley, toward Weatherby. They crossed the street when they saw me & continued east on Huntley. I was headed west on Huntley.
09/23/2016	6:30 pm	Remains discovered in front yard on Kempton between Chianti and Ballantine	Scattered bones, front paws, tale and fur on one property. Fur remains on adjacent property. Remains appeared to be 12-18 hours old.
09/26/2016	7:00 am	12571 Silver Fox Road	Discovered remains of a brown cat in front yard.
09/30/2016	1:24 am	3332 Kenilworth Dr Rossmoor	2 coyotes came to our front lawn, the security camera and motion detector's lights came on but they did not care. The attack an animal and ate it in my front lawn. We found the remains of what look like a tabby cat or rabbit. (photo available)
10/1/2016	12:00 midnight	12021 Chaucer Rd	Found partial remains of a cat on my front lawn (photo available)
10/1/2016	7:44 am	On Chaucer Road, running south towards Kempton	Running south down street; medium sized. Cat remains found that morning just north on Chaucer at Bradbury.
10/6/2016	6:30 am	On Kempton at Chaucer Rd.	2 medium sized coyotes eating an animal on a neighbor's front lawn. May have been a cat or raccoon. Flashed headlights at them. Did not phase them.

10/08/2016	6:15 am	Silver fox and Inverness	Relatively small coyote trotting west on Inverness and turned south onto silver fox
10/13/2016	11:20 pm	In Rossmoor Park near Pemberton Ave sidewalk closest to the baseball diamond on the Northeast corner of Pemberton and Foster.	Both Coyotes were between 50-70 lbs. one was larger than the other. They were taking a casual stroll through the park. They weren't scared off by me or my husband as we took pictures. We were approximately 40 feet from them. They stopped, stared, then just casually walked through the middle of the park southbound towards my street, Baskerville Rd. One went south, the other went north. We stayed for about 5 minutes and just watched them from a distance. At one point the smaller one just sat in the middle of the grass like a dog. I have 4 small kids and I don't care to see these animals roaming near my house. (photos available)
10/16/2016	7:30 am	11262 Kensington Rd	On my driveway was a small animal's guts. It looked like a long piece of rope. Probably a cat. My neighbor thought a bird must have dropped it because no other evidence was near.
