Coyote activity sightings have decreased since the September/October report. It seems that as we move deeper into the fall, and the gates have been fixed, there is less activity in Rossmoor

Date	Time	Location	Description
10/20	6:40 am	Baskerville btwn Kerth & Drysdale	<p>I was on morning walk headed SW in street on Baskerville. Turned around to see if I could see a cat I sometimes see around there. Instead, I see a coyote, on the sidewalk, about one house away, going my same direction. He appeared to be following me but could have been simply walking the same way.</p> <p>I flailed, yelled, stomped feet, used air horn and chased it. It ran towards Rossmoor park there were people there). I waited and chased it more until it left the park. I believe it went S on Donovan but I lost it when I went there looking for it. Warned the park goers.</p>
10/28	8:00 am	Rossmoor Park - right field area softball diamond 2 across from Pemberton	The remains of an animal jaw/teeth. Given the size of the head and the tooth structure, I feel quite certain it was a cat.
11/2	7:00 am	11341 Loch Lomond Road	Remains of a black cat on my front lawn (including tail and paw).
11/2	7:30 am	Chesney & Loch Lomond	My cat's remains were found two houses down. A foot was all that was left.

11/9	11:45 pm	Corner of Wallingsford & Kenilworth. Lawn of 3351 Kenilworth.	I was driving up Wallingsford from Orangetown and slowed when I saw what I thought was a husky at the corner of someone's lawn. When I slowed down, it looked at me and another large coyote joined it. It then ran on the street up Wallingsford towards Huntley
