Summary:

Coyote activity sightings have remained flat since the October report. It seems that as we move into winter, and the gates have been fixed, there is less activity in Rossmoor.

5 reports submitted, 2 coyote sightings, 1 remains (reported twice).

12/18	9:00 p.m.	Foster @ Main Way	Coyote was heading toward N/W corner of Rush Park
12/18	9:30 p.m.	on the lawn outside the wall on Katella Ave	The coyote was trotting along in the direction of the freeway. Medium size.
12/31	1:30 a.m.	Loch Lomond between Shakespeare and Chesney	My sister in law, who was visiting, had taken my 16-month-old niece out for a walk to get her back to sleep for the night. As she returned to our home she noticed the coyote making its way down the street toward her. She returned to the house as quickly as possible. About the size of a medium sized dog from her report.
1/3/17	5:515 a.m.	2752 Kempton	Walking toward my house going east on Kempton, stopped in street when he saw me. I yelled quickly. It turned and ran away back west toward Martha ann.
1/8	6:15 a.m.	Blume & Foster	My husband and I were walking our dogs, we were walking on Blume toward Foster and a large coyote (size of a German Shepard) ran down Foster towards Copa De Oro, by the time we got to the Foster the coyote was gone.
