5/16/2017	8:10 a.m.	Montecito/Orangewood near Shakespeare	On the sidewalk on Montecito near Shakespeare across the street from Rossmoor School I saw a completely chewed down to the bones leg of a cat. The paw with brown fur was the only thing remaining. Pretty awful. I posted it on Nextdoor.com without going into any descriptive detail or showing any picture. I did not take a picture. Very brutal sight! A couple people responded on Nextdoor.com that they had heard it happen the previous night (5-15-17).
6/18/2017	8:00 a.m.	Lee Elementary School	Husband was walking dog across the field found part of a back leg, part of a tail and innards. Black and white fur. In back of Lee School near the funnel ball courts.
