January 17, 2018 – February 20, 2018 Coyote Reporting Summary

Summary:

Two reports this month one late night and the other early morning. One is towards the north end of the tract and the other is toward the south end. No real pattern.

1/19/2018	3441 Oranewood Ave	11:30 PM	2 coyotes crossing the street - Oranewood near Los Al Blvd
1/27/2018	12462 Martha Ann Dr	6:30 AM	Large size running down Martha Ann and went towards Hopkinson elementary school

Recall that coyotes are simple. They seek food, shelter, and water. There is no real way for Rossmoor to eliminate “water” from the list. Shelter for the most part is not available in Rossmoor. So, it comes down to food sources. As long as there are convenient food sources in Rossmoor and the coyotes can get into Rossmoor, they will be here. There’s not an effective way to keep them out beyond the coyote gates that are very effective, but not a complete solution. Coyotes enter Rossmoor via streets and storm drain channels, primarily from the east.
