March 21, 2018 – April 17, 2018 Coyote Reporting Summary

Summary:

Two reports this month one late night and the other early morning. Both reports are toward the middle of the tract.

4/1/2018	2881 Coleridge Dr	6:20 AM	One coyote, running SB on west sidewalk of Foster, then turning west on Coleridge. I yelled at it just to hopefully instill / keep fear of humans. It disappeared, either running into the ivy / foliage of that corner house or jumping in a backyard. It did not run further on the sidewalk.
3/24/2018	11601 Wembley Rd	11:07 PM	Two coyotes trotting on sidewalk southbound at 11601 Wembley Rd. There could have been more. I immediately saw one and then another about 30' behind.

Recall that coyotes are simple. They seek food, shelter, and water. There is no real way for Rossmoor to eliminate “water” from the list. Shelter for the most part is not available in Rossmoor. So, it comes down to food sources. As long as there are convenient food sources in Rossmoor and the coyotes can get into Rossmoor, they will be here. There’s not an effective way to keep them out beyond the coyote gates that are very effective, but not a complete solution. Coyotes enter Rossmoor via streets and storm drain channels, primarily from the east.
